

PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

Kinesiology, Sports Studies and Physical Education Department (KSSPE), SUNY Brockport

and

Physical Education and Sports Studies Department, Broome Community College

I. INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the State University of New York's transfer policy the document herewith has been drafted between the Broome Community College and SUNY Brockport's KSSPE Department. The intent is to facilitate students of Broome Community College transferring to SUNY Brockport and pursuing the Physical Education Teacher Education major or Kinesiology major.

II. TRANSFER TO SUNY BROCKPORT

The number of hours to be transferred and the allocation of such hours shall be determined by the following policies:

A. Total Transfer Credit

1. From two-year colleges.

- a. Students holding an approved associate degree from a regionally accredited college may transfer up to 75 credits. Such students will automatically be granted at least 60 credits and junior status. Some students may need more than 60 additional credits to complete the baccalaureate degree requirements depending on previous courses and the major and other academic programs selected at SUNY Brockport.
- b. Students without an associate degree from a regionally accredited college may transfer up to 75 credits and be granted junior status

2. **From four-year colleges.** A total of 90 credits may be accepted for transfer from any regionally accredited four-year college or university.
