

Quick guide for electronics and appliances

Not allowed in Resident Suite:

- Multi-plug/ Tri-tap adapters
- Halogen lamps, black lights, lava lamps or other high intensity lamps including torchier lamps, spider lamps, or upward facing bowl lamps.
- Coffee makers
- Toaster ovens / hot plates
- Foreman or similar grills
- Electric Fry Pans
- Waffle, sandwich, quesadilla makers
- Oil fryers
- Auxiliary heaters
- Refrigerators exceeding 4.0cu/ft
- Air conditioners
- Non fire treated curtains/ flags / and tapestries

Allowed in Resident Suite:

- ALL electronics and appliances must be UL APPROVED
- ALL electrical devices must be plugged directly into a wall outlet or approved power strip (Power strip containing a circuit breaker).
- Keurig style coffee maker
- Computer
- TV/DVD/Video gaming system
- Fire treated curtains/ flags / tapestry * *(must have tags and documentation meeting NFPA 701)
